


The residents will be working with Dr. Sheldon at Buffalo General Medical Center.

Interviews and Boston Scientific Skills Labs

This year the resident interview sessions were held on October 26th, November 2nd and December 7th. A total of 52 incredible candidates were interviewed. We are very pleased with our Match, and look forward to working with our incoming residents.

On each interview day, while some of the applicants were interviewing with faculty, the residents took the other applicants to the Jacobs School in the UB RISE Surgical Skills Lab where they had the opportunity to have hands-on experience using urology devices. The skills labs were organized in cooperation with Boston Scientific, Dr. Schwaitzberg's UB RISE Surgical Skills Lab, and Dr. Christopher Skomra.

The October 26th skills lab's program goal was to provide a life-like, hands-on interactive educational opportunity by using the f-URS with Lumenis MOSES P120W laser, and the f-URS skills challenge with LithoVue scope/empower retrieval device and baskets using segmented box models.

On November 2nd, stations included Rezum Vapor Therapy simulator for BPH, Greenlight simulator for BPH, SpaceOAR simulator for Oncology and f-URS with LithoVue and KUB model station without a laser.

Finally, the December 7th skills lab focused on Women's Incontinence (slings and bulking

agent) and possible POP treatment, as well as Men's Incontinence and Erectile Restoration.

The feedback received from both the residents and applicants was overwhelmingly positive. Applicants stated it was the first time at an interview where they had the opportunity not only to see a skills lab, but to actually have hands-on experience.

AUA In-Service Exam

Congratulations to our residents! They all studied hard this year and were rewarded with the results. Our residents scored higher than the national average on all but three of the 15 areas tested. Keep up the hard work!


