On Tuesday, April 12th, we were honored to have a very special and important lecture with distinguished guest speaker Dr. Vinay Prasad. This lecture gave all attendees a unique opportunity to hear from a renowned leader in the field of Hematology-Oncology and Epidemiology with a keen interest in critical review of literature and policy makers.

Vinay Prasad MD MPH is a hematologist-oncologist and Associate Professor in the Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics at the University of California San Francisco. He runs the VKPrasad lab at UCSF, which studies cancer drugs, health policy, clinical trials and better decision making. He is author of over 350 academic articles, and the books Ending Medical Reversal (2015), and Malignant (2020). He hosts the oncology podcast Plenary Session and runs a YouTube Channel VinayPrasadMDMPH.

His lecture titled "Critical Thinking and Literature Review" was held via Zoom with a tremendous turnout of faculty, residents, students, nurses and staff. After his presentation, Dr. Prasad dissected, reviewed, and discussed two select articles titled, 'Oral Relugolix for Androgen-Deprivation Therapy in Advanced Prostate Cancer' and 'Neoadjuvant Chemotherapy plus Cystectomy Compared with Cystectomy Alone for Locally Advanced Bladder Cancer'.


Department of Urology Presentations by Visiting Professors
